EXPERT'S REPORT

In November 2001, we launched a first series of tests with a product by researcher and inventor Ingeborg Reden.

The first test examined the effects of the gold plated hexagonal apparatus, which we attached to the water tap we use for watering the plants.

We studied different plant species, concentrating on those who suffer especially in autumn and winter due to receiving less daylight. The poor performance of these plants includes a lowered resistance, increased leaf loss and susceptibility towards pests. We have been observing this "winterly depression" year after year.

To our great surprise, we noticed that all plants, no matter which species kept their dark green color. They rarely lost leaves and in contrast to past years, pests were close to absent. Additionally, we hardly needed to use fertilizer. Obviously, light quantums replace traditional light energy, which is low in the autumn and winter months. Water receives its primal information. Its surface tension changes. In this energetic environment plants experience highest vitality. This is valid through all seasons. Thus, you can make enormous savings on fertilizers and pesticides. In addition, this implies organic gardening becoming much easier to practice.

Currently, we are conducting a test studying 1200 different species of orchids. These plants are difficult and costly to cultivate and require a lot of special care.

In this year's spring, in the beginning of March we additionally placed three different water discs in the laboratory pools of the Botanical Garden of the University of Salzburg. These discs are one pool disc, 25 cm. in diameter, which is made from metal, plus one big and one small disc both made from acrylic (Metraton disc).

We placed different species of water plants in the individual basins, planted into "zoolith" (sedimentary rock containing processed animal remains). We did not replace the water since it first was filled into the basins in April 2001.

Because water plants naturally need time to develop, their bioregulative function normally only is noticeable from June onwards. Astonishingly, in spite of very warm weather conditions, the water quality was excellent.

According to our analyses, this is due to a neutralization of eutrophic processes. This neutralization can be attributed to a change in the water structure (different pattern of oscillation).

Given the very warm conditions during this year's Summer (very hot weather in June) we are surprised the water is in perfect condition. It appears clean and algae are absent. This is even more remarkable, since the basins carry only few plants, have no fresh water supply, and are hardly oxygenated through surface movement.

We believe the possibilities for using the water discs are very wide. They could be used in swimming pools, garden-ponds, in fish-farming, watering tanks, also in combination with the water vitalization apparatus (such as the hexagonal apparatus for swimming pools). Only Ingeborg Reden is able to determine the size of the apparatus needed.

Physics have proven that photon light is an ultra weak field. It has the highest structuration efficiency as an entropic force.

In the meantime, Ingeborg Reden's technology has been registered for patenting. Renowned scientists have performed a number of scientifically sound tests. This equipment solely works with light, light quantum and photons. This promises a fascinating future without energy consumption, deterioration or pollution. The equipment needs very little space and can be used everywhere. These products are free from radiation. They keep their functional principle permanently. They are totally en-

vironmentally friendly and maintenance-free. The only thing that might be necessary is an occasional cleansing of their surface.

For many years we have been experiencing problems in our garden due to voles and mice which cause considerable damage. The use of neither traps, nor bait or cats helped. Their effect cannot be compared to what we have seen in the last months due to the use of Ingeborg Reden's equipment. Although you still can see vole activity in some places, hardly any plants have been eaten away.

Due to our very good experiences, we are fully convinced that Ingeborg Reden's technology is most useful. This technology offers a reason to hope in a time where resources of our planet are plundered and energy is wasted. The members of the Botanical Institute and the Botanical Garden will continue to follow these developments with great interest, experimenting with innovations in order to aid general acceptance of these relevant insights.
